

Community Events through Union Memorial Hospital

Health Fair: Despite an earthquake, a hurricane and torrential downpours, the skies were bright and clear the morning of September 10, just in time for the health fair held in partnership with Union Memorial Hospital. More than 100 community members benefited from the health fair. The most popular exhibitor was the blood pressure screening, and attendees also had access to nutrition counseling, heart health education, orthopedics and sports medicine information, an eye-opening hand-washing tutorial and diabetes education (just to name a few). The team of exhibitors and nurses could not have been more welcoming.



Blood Drive: On October 12 from 3–7 p.m., the center held a blood drive in partnership with MedStar Health Blood Donor Services. Despite a downcast and soggy day, we were quite pleased with the number of donors who came through the doors. Blood collected that day went directly to MedStar blood banks servicing their hospitals and thus staying in the Baltimore metropolitan community. Plans are already underway for another blood drive to be held in January.

Flu Shots: On October 27, the center was happy to work with Union Memorial Hospital to provide free flu shots to the community. More than 100 residents received their flu shots, and will hopefully enjoy a flu-free year. We are thankful that Union Memorial Hospital subsidized these flu shots, as many residents are uninsured and unable to afford one.

These events are just the beginning of a burgeoning partnership with Union Memorial Hospital. Later in the year, we are pleased to offer various health screenings, here, at the Family Center, which will be facilitated by Union Memorial Hospital staff.
